

2013 President's Volunteer Service Award

Taiwanese Youth Arts Foundation, Inc. & Washington DC Taiwanese School

Purpose: To recognize and honor volunteers for their commitment and community service to the Taiwanese Youth Arts Foundation and the Washington DC Taiwanese School.

Awards: Recognized award recipients receive:

- An official President's Volunteer Service Award pin.
- A personalized certificate of achievement.
- A note of congratulations from the President of the United States.
- A letter from the President's Council on Service Participation.

Award Criteria: Any individual, family, or group is eligible for recognition of volunteer hours earned over a 12-month period. The following are the volunteer requirements for each group:

- Youth (14 and under): 50 or more volunteer hours
- Young Adults (15 to 20): 100 or more volunteer hours
- Adults (over 20): 100 or more volunteer hours
- Family & Group: 200 or more volunteer hours
- At least 40 % of the required community service hours are for activities sponsored/co-sponsored by the TYAF and/or the Taiwanese School.

How to Apply: Complete the application form.

Award Selection: The TYAF and the Taiwanese School will verify the service records and submit the qualified recipient's record to the President's Council on Service and Civic Participation for final consideration. The recognized service volunteers will be announced by the TYAF/Taiwanese School at the 2014 TAAGWC annual event.

Application Deadline: Applications must be post-marked by **November 15, 2013**.
